

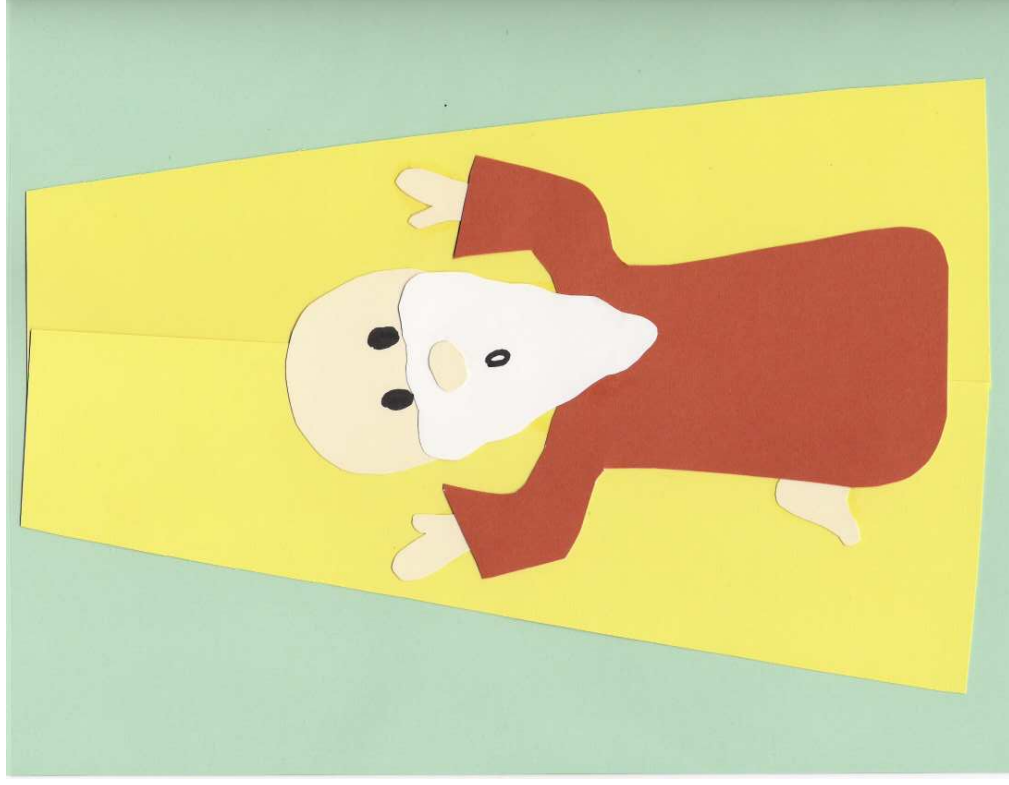

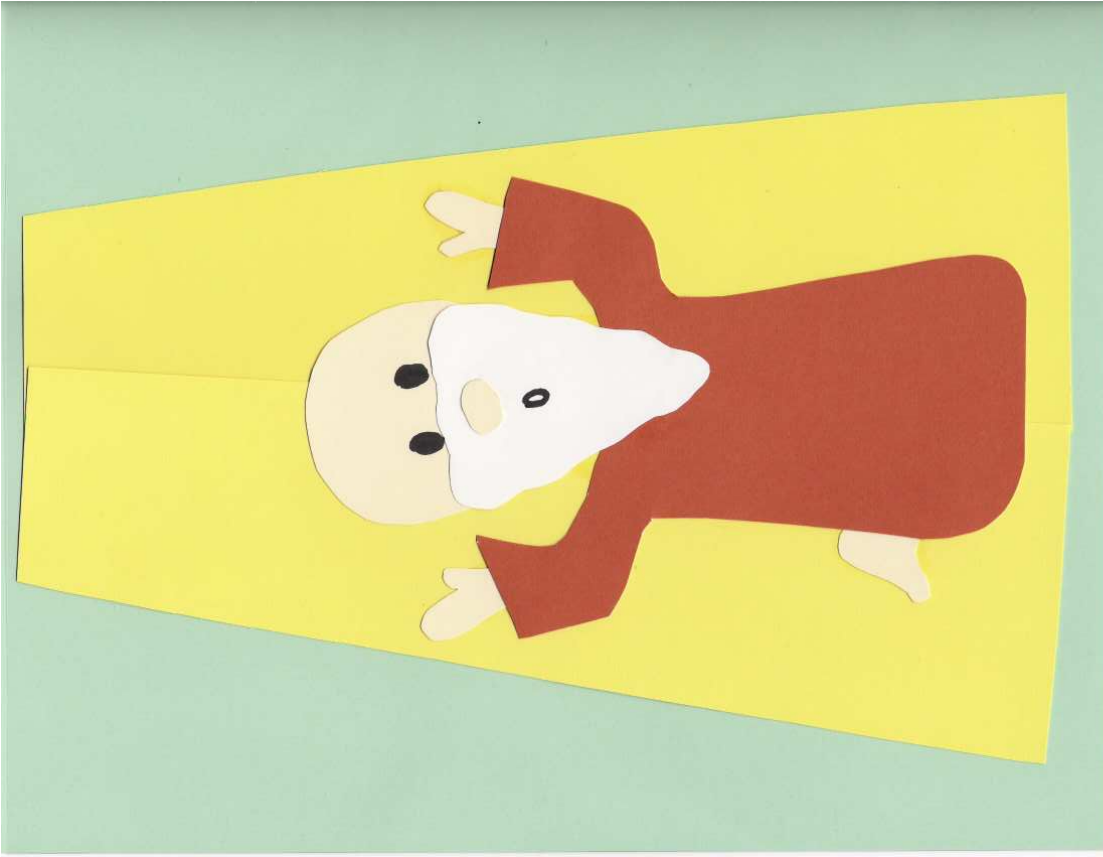

How do we know God is real?

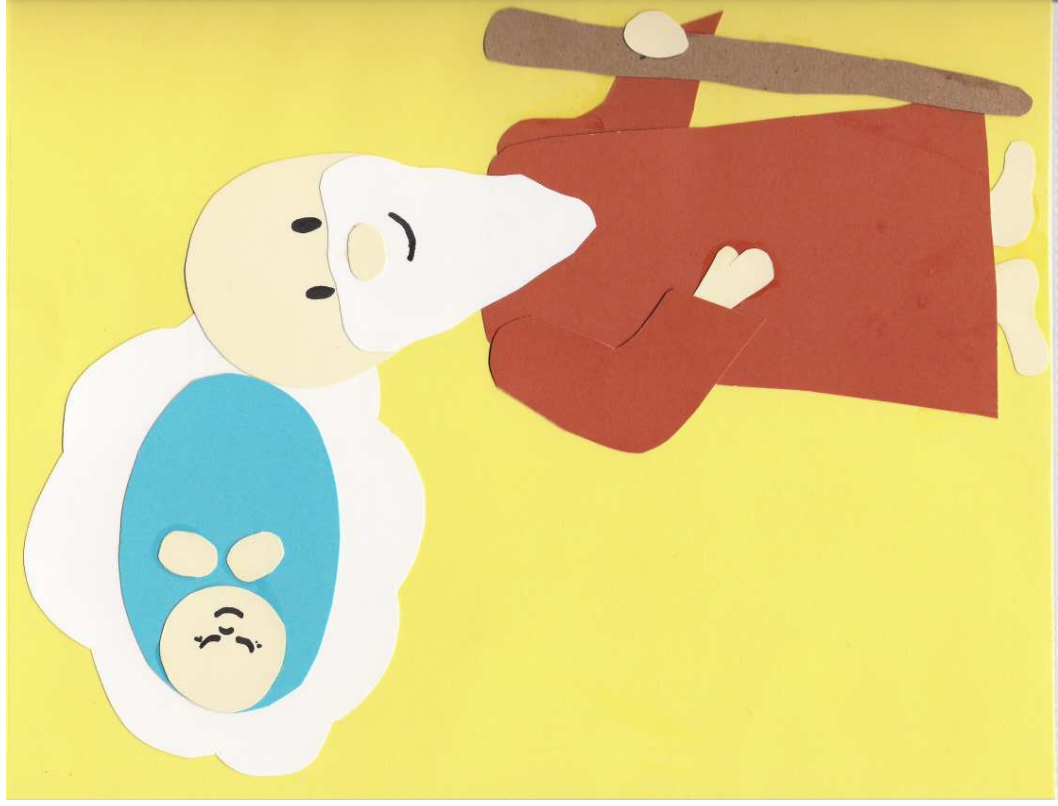
God promises to love you always.

Once there was a man named Abraham. He lived a very long time ago and loved God very much.

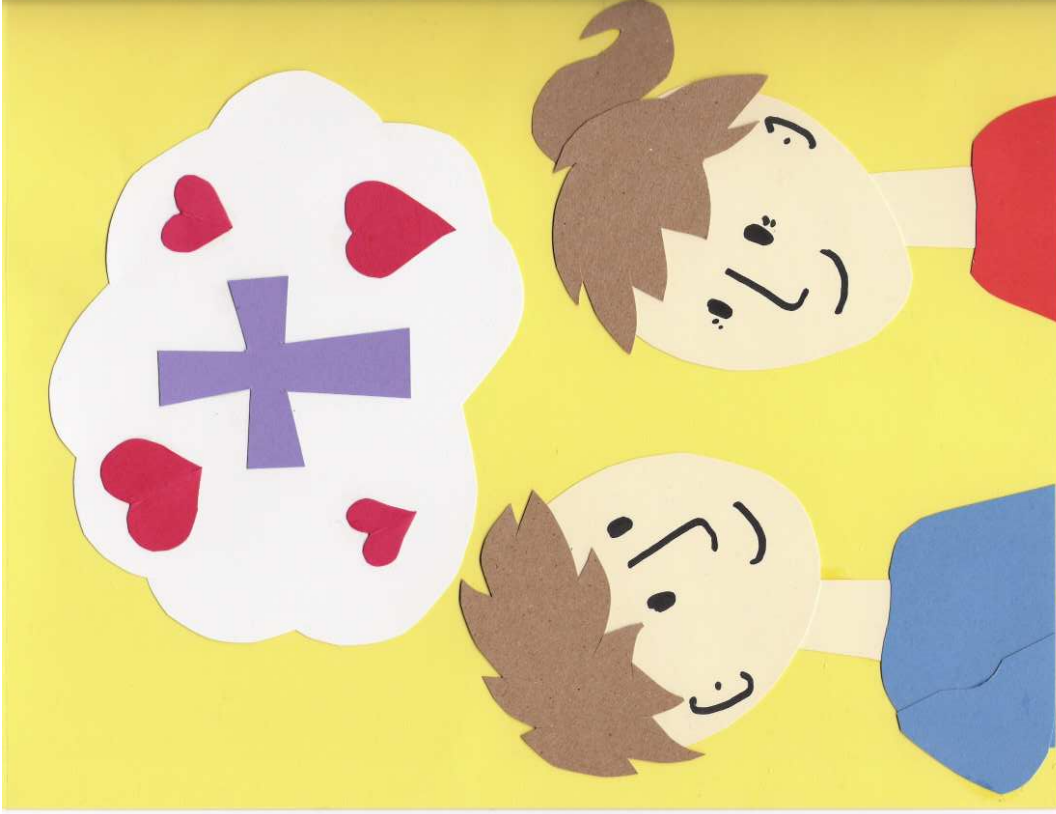
When he was very old, God came to him and said, "Abraham, I'm going to give you a son."

Abraham and Sarah were so happy to have Isaac. They thanked God and knew that He could do anything.

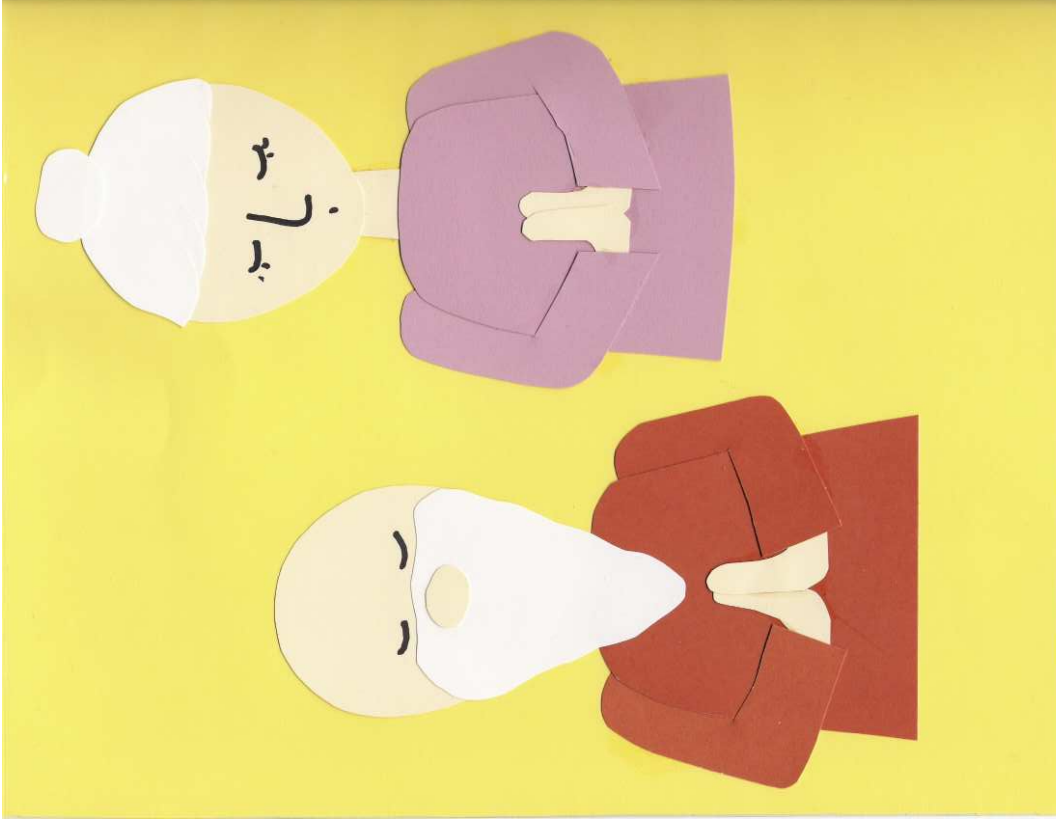


Abraham was married to a woman named Sarah. Sarah was also surprised that God would give her a son, because she was very old too.
