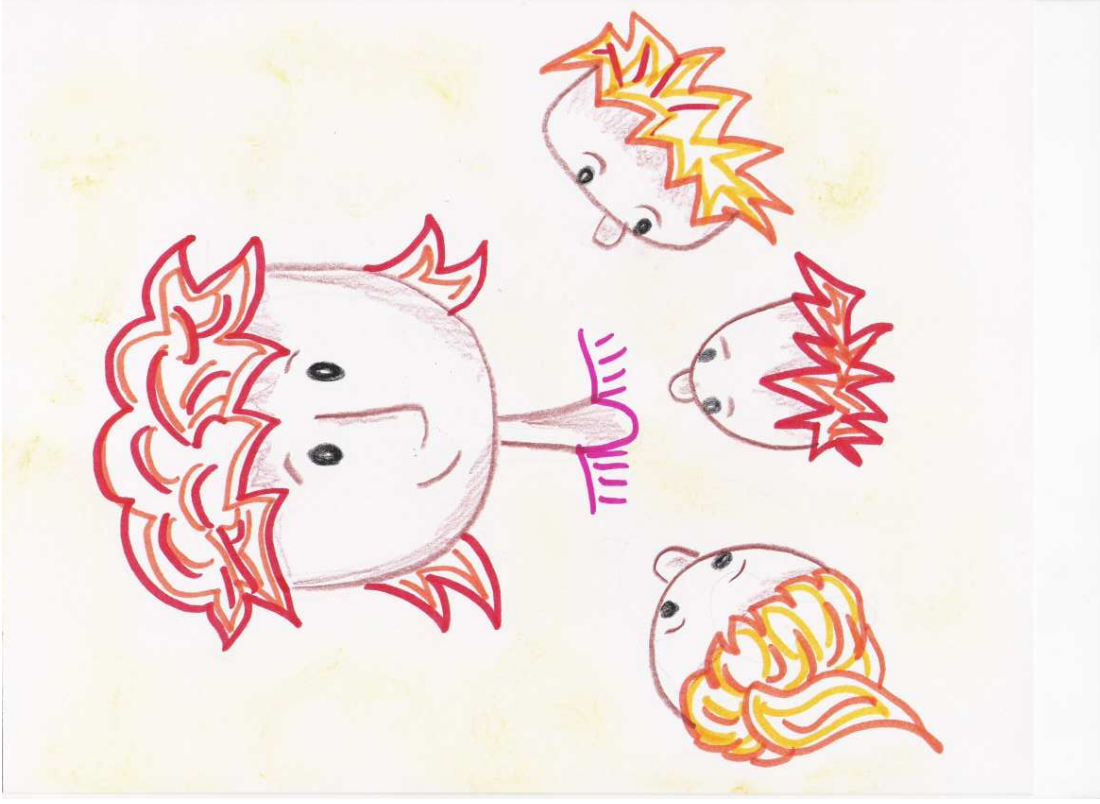

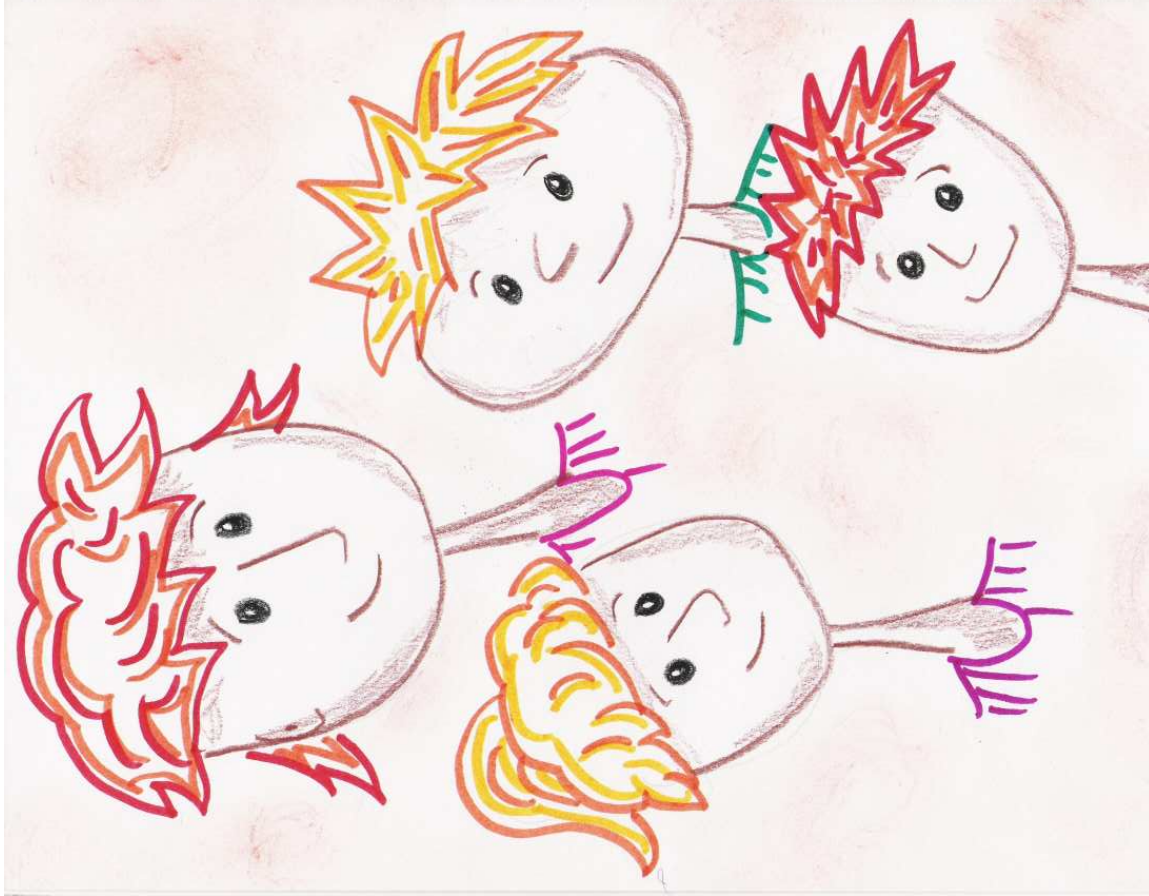

What is salvation?

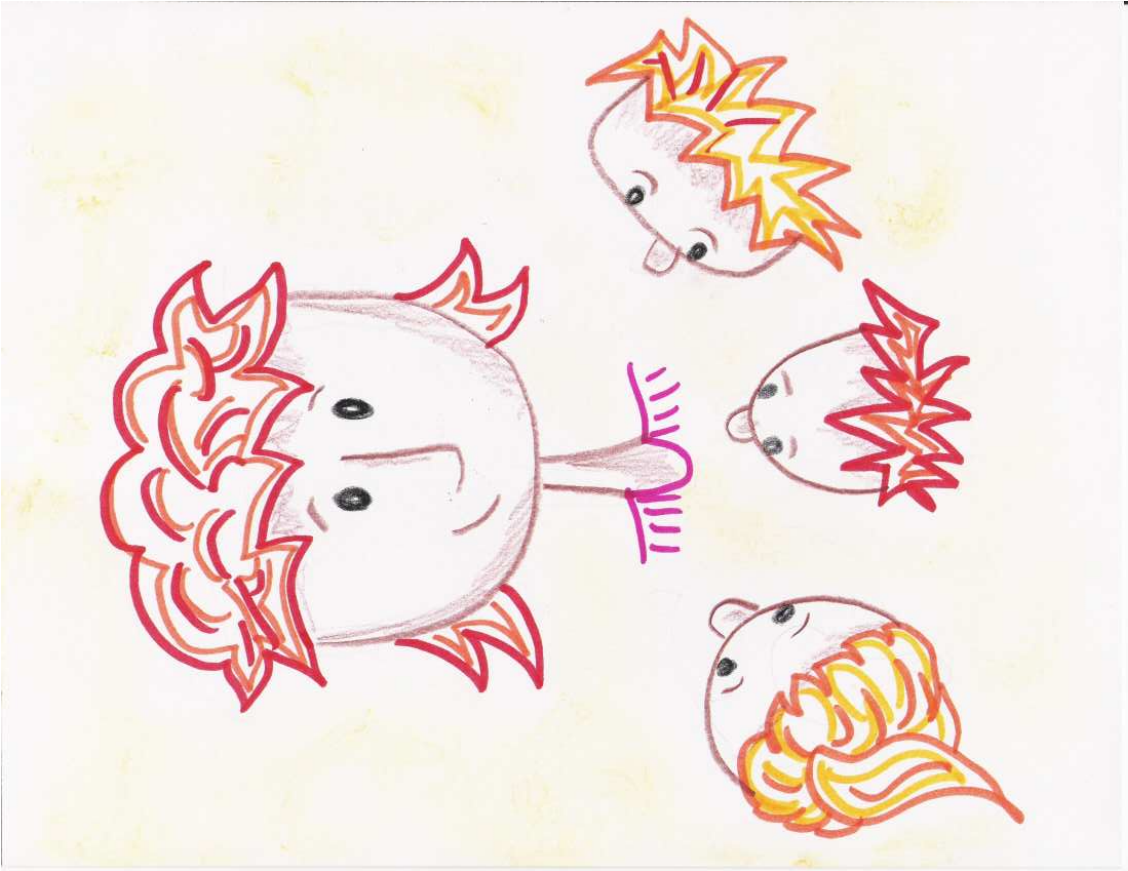
"What is Salvation?" asked Skyler one evening at bedtime.

“God is holy; he cannot be with sinners.”



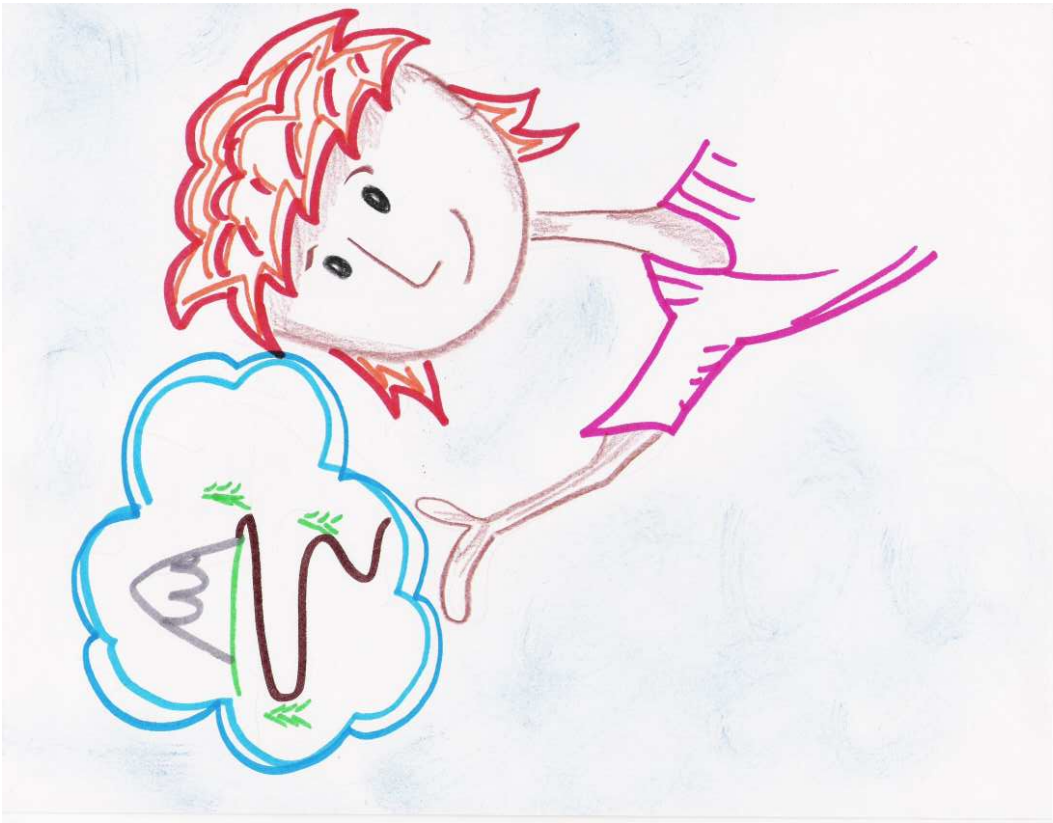
“What happens if we don’t ask for salvation?” Skyler was curious.
